



## IMPACT OF CLIMATE CHANGE ON BIODIVERSITY

It is now well established that the world is heating up. The average temperature of the Earth's surface increased by an estimated 0.6°C in the 20th century, and according to the most recent projections of the Intergovernmental Panel on Climate Change, could rise 1.4 to 5.8°C above the 1990 average by 2100. Much of this predicted increase is attributed by scientists to increasing concentrations of greenhouse gases such as carbon dioxide (CO<sub>2</sub>) in the atmosphere.

The effects of such a temperature increase might include:

- more frequent extreme high maximum temperatures and less frequent extreme low minimum temperatures
- a decrease in snow cover: satellite observations suggest that the area of the planet covered by snow has already declined by 10 per cent since the 1960s
- rising sea levels
- an increase in the variability of climate

According to India's National Action Plan on Climate Change (IPCC), multi-model averages show that the temperature increases during 2090- 2099 relative to 1980-1999 may range from 1.1 to 6.4°C and sea level rise from 0.18 to 0.59 meters. These could lead to impacts on freshwater availability, oceanic acidification, food production, flooding of coastal areas and increased burden of vector. In recent assessment, it is presumed that 20-30% of species assessed so far are likely to be at increased risk of extinction if increases in global average warming exceed 1.5-2.5°C (relative to 1980-1999) and as global average temperature increase exceeds about 3.5°C, model projections suggest significant extinctions (40-70% of species

assessed) around the globe. Global warming does not only make vegetation "gasp for air" but also leads to animal habitat loss. This is an especially big problem for sensitive species. The loss of these habitats leads to air borne and water borne diseases associated with extreme weather events.

Biodiversity reflects the number, variety and variability of living organisms. It includes diversity within species, between species, and among ecosystem. The concept also covers how this diversity changes from one location to another and over time. Indicators such as the number of species in a given area can help in monitoring certain aspects of biodiversity.

Climate change could have dramatic effects on a wide range of India's plants and animals. Conservation of wildlife and biodiversity in natural heritage sites including sacred groves, protected areas and other biodiversity 'hotspots' is crucial for maintaining the resilience of ecosystems.

For conservation of biodiversity the following actions should be taken:

- In-situ and ex-situ conservation of genetic resources, especially of threatened flora and fauna.
- Creation of biodiversity registers (at national, district, and local levels) for documenting genetic diversity and the associated traditional knowledge.
- Effective implementation of the Protected Area System under the Wildlife Conservation Act.
- Effective implementation of the National Biodiversity Conservation Act, 2001

# Subhash Chandra Bose Biography

## Introduction

Subhash Chandra Bose's birthday is on the 23rd of January 1897, Netaji Subhash Chandra Bose was born in Cuttack. He was born to Janakinath Bose and Prabhavati Dutt. He was an Indian nationalist in the era of British colonialism in India whose defiant patriotism and immovable nerve and bravery made him a national hero whose praises are still sung with pride by every Indian citizen. His attempts to get rid of the British with the help of the Nazi party and Imperial Japan during the time of the second world war left him a troubled legacy. Although every Indian feels proud by hearing his name, it was not the case during the freedom struggle, especially in the INC where he often faced clashes of ideologies with Gandhiji and he did not get the recognition that he deserved. Let us take a look into the life of this extraordinary yet unsung hero. In honour of his contribution to the freedom struggle recently it was announced that his birthday is celebrated as "PARAKRAM DIWAS" as "parakram" translates to courage in English thereby recognizing his immense contribution by calling his birthday the day of courage. The day will now be commemorated each year in memory of Netaji Subhash Chandra Bose, the unsung hero of the Indian independence struggle! Let us look at the Subhash Chandra Bose Biography and know our hero, in and out!

## Education

Subhas Chandra Bose was the ninth out of the fourteen children of Janakinath Bose and Prabhavati Dutt. He attended the Protestant European School, which is now called Stewart High School, along with his other siblings in Cuttack. He was a brilliant student and had a knack for knowing which earned him a second position in the matriculation exam. He attended the Presidency College (now University) in Calcutta and was greatly influenced by the teachings and philosophies of Swami Vivekananda and Shri Ramakrishna Paramhansa Dev by reading their works when he was 16 years old.

Subhas Chandra Bose joined the Indian National Congress (INC) under the influence of Mahatma Gandhi and started the newspapers called "Swaraj" which means self-governance which marks his entry into politics and his role in the freedom struggle in India has just started. Chittaranjan Das was his mentor. In the year 1923, he became the President of the All India Youth Congress and became the editor of the newspaper "Forward" started by C.R. Das himself. He had also been elected as the mayor of Calcutta back then. He gained leadership spirit and made his way up to the top in the INC very soon. In 1928, the Motilal Nehru Committee demanded Dominion Status in India but Subhash Chandra Bose along with Jawaharlal Nehru asserted that nothing would satisfy other than complete independence of India from the British. Gandhiji strongly opposed the ways of Bose, who wanted independence by hook or by crook, as he was a firm believer of non-violence itself.

He was sent to jail in 1930 during the Civil Disobedience movement but was released along with other prominent leaders in the year 1931 when the Gandhi-Irwin pact was signed. In 1938, he was elected as President at the Haripura session of the INC and re-elected at the Tripuri Session in 1939 by competing against Dr P. Sitaramayya who was supported by Gandhi himself. He maintained strict standards during the commencement of the first World War and demanded full independence of India from the British within six months. He faced vehement objections from inside the Congress which led him to resign from INC and form a more progressive group called the "Forward Bloc".

He started a mass movement against using Indian men in the wars of foreign countries which received immense support and voice which led him to be put under house arrest in Calcutta but he left the house in disguise in January 1941 and reached Germany via Afghanistan and met the Nazi leader there to seek help from them to drive the British away from India. He also sought help from Japan. He made full use of the philosophy "an enemy's enemy is a friend".

## **A Critical Note on Preface to Lyrical Ballads**

**Dr Sudhanshu Shekhar Dwibedy**  
Former Principal,  
SSB College, Mahakalapara.

Lyrical Ballads is a joint publication by William Wordsworth and an equally accomplished poet Samuel Taylor Coleridge, which is cited as the most prominent reason responsible for the launch of Romantic Age in English Literature. Preface to this text therefore is of utmost importance to me, being a student of English literature. It is evident that this collection of poems is intended at the masses and not merely the aristocracy or those highly placed as previously the case would be, and specially so, common men. Never before had poems dared to address the theme of 'low and rustic'. This quality defines well the reason why a work of this nature must be called 'revolutionary'. It didn't only change the way humanity would look at poems but also attempted to question the moral values of the then society and hoped for much needed change, which brings me to say that the intension of the initiative was as noble as the cause. Lyrical Ballads is an exhausting explanation (calling it defence might outrage Mr. Wordsworth) which even though with initial reluctance, later upon the insistence of good wishers is pursued rigorously and presented before us as an imperfectly constructed litigation document contradicting its own stand after every few pages. In the very beginning Wordsworth denies the charges of reasoning the

reader into an approbation of his work, however in the very next paragraph he very cleverly ridicules the works of everyone from Terence to Shakespeare to Donne to Pope. He stoops to every low possible, right from questioning the integrity and character of every poet before him to calling the critics of his work as being in unhealthy state of association, thus manifesting his bigoted self. Further, another thing which is as perplexing as it is amusing is that he chooses to see flaws in every aspect of the poets before him and shamelessly endorses his ignorance of 'vulgarity and meanness of ordinary life', of 'men' whom he repeatedly calls 'flesh and blood' and whom he so passionately boasts of including as a subject of his poems, I however appreciate his choice being unostentatious in the language of the poetic content. Perplexing because while it is a commendable endeavor to include those who've been shunned forages, unaccepted by those whom he refers to as intelligent readers, forget alone being muses of such an art, but what justification would Mr. Wordsworth offer to the Poets whom he accuses of collecting 'the sympathies of men, and indulge in arbitrary and capricious habits of expression, in order to furnish food for fickle tastes, and fickle appetites, of their own creation' not to mention being 'slavish and mechanical', is not it then amusing that he relentlessly advocates the cause of common men, knowing well of 'the great national events', 'accumulation of men in cities' and 'craving for extraordinary incident'? Is he himself not appeasing a section of men whom he predicts shall rule tomorrow? Is

this not the kind of description a man tired of atrocities of the upper class yearns to hear? His brilliance is sure worth a mention for how well he manipulates us into affirming to his standards of morality. Though I am completely empathetic with the mammoth task he'd ventured himself into and the world of good that it had the potential to bestow upon the then completely savagely world, but having said that, it is no justification for all the callousness he's offered to us which in fact has ended up affronting the sensibilities of many, including me. I personally feel that the Preface to Lyrics Ballads was least essential and has ended up being a scar on the image of an otherwise marvelous Poet. The wings of change had witnessed a flight of its own just when the first volume of these poems was published without a preface.

## **A Brief Report on Intellectual Property Rights**

These are the rights given to persons over the creations of their minds. They usually give the creator an exclusive right over the use of his/her creation for a certain period of time.

Intellectual property rights are customarily divided into two main areas:

The rights of authors of literary and artistic works (such as books and other writings, musical compositions, paintings, sculpture, computer programs and films) are protected by copyright, for a minimum period of 50 years after the death of the author. Also protected through copyright and related (sometimes referred to as “neighbouring”) rights are the rights of performers (e.g. actors, singers and musicians), producers of phonograms (sound recordings) and broadcasting organizations.

The main social purpose of protection of copyright and related rights is to encourage and reward creative work. Industrial property can usefully be divided into two main areas: One area can be characterized as the protection of distinctive signs, in particular trademarks (which distinguish the goods or services of one undertaking from those of other undertakings) and geographical indications (which identify a good as originating in a place where a given characteristic of the good is essentially attributable to its geographical origin). The protection of such distinctive signs aims to stimulate and ensure fair competition and to protect consumers, by enabling them to make informed choices between various goods and


services. The protection may last indefinitely, provided the sign in question continues to be distinctive. Other types of industrial property are protected primarily to stimulate innovation, design and the creation of technology. In this category fall inventions (protected by patents), industrial designs and trade secrets. The social purpose is to provide protection for the results of investment in the development of new technology, thus giving the incentive and means to finance research and development activities. A functioning intellectual property regime should also facilitate the transfer of technology in the form of foreign direct investment, joint ventures and licensing. The protection is usually given for a finite term (typically 20 years in the case of patents).










**Seminar Report on "GST@7: Threats and Curatives"**





