

#### *Impact and Significance*




4. **Donation and Distribution:** As part of the community service, students and faculty members donated clothes, toys, books, and other essential items to the children at the agency.

### *Event Highlights:*



### *6. Feedback Session*





## **Key Observations**

## YRC Report for the session 2023-2024


The Youth Red Cross Society of this college is striving hard to induce among the students the spirit of active involvement in the service of the community by organizing several camps and programmes.



The Social Activities committee conducted the following six Activities.


- 1) Voter Registration and its Awareness.





for public awareness like announcement was being done last two days before the program.


Both Rajnagar C.H.C and Pattamundai C.H.C offered their supporting hand to make the program a success.
